Added to the exhibits this year is a collection of professional and personal items to commemorate the life, service, and courage of Tell City Police Department Sergeant Heather Glenn, who was tragically killed while serving the Tell City community on July 3, 2023. A lifelong Tell City resident, Sergeant Glenn became the first woman to ever serve as a full-time police officer for the Tell City Police Department. Known for her love of people and animals alike, Sergeant Glenn left a legacy to model the standards of service and quality of life that we have come to expect and enjoy. "It is not how she died that made her a hero, it is how she lived."
